



“Farms for a Cure” with the American Cancer Society’s annual “Relay for Life” Event

For the 10th year, JYG partnered with the American Cancer Society for Relay for Life, an all-night event that raises money for cancer research. Relay for Life celebrates, remembers and honors cancer survivors and the lives that have been lost to cancer by raising money to fight the disease.

This year, the JYG Relay for Life team chose the theme Farming for a Cure. The theme used scenes and tasks for everyday life on a farm to create a fun atmosphere in which to raise money

for a cure. Using interactive activities to provide prevention tips, the team engaged passersby in learning about how to prevent cancer.

For the second year in a row, JYG won 1st place in tent decorations for the Corporate category for our design and incorporation of prevention tips into our theme. The team raised over \$2,200 at the event, in addition to the nearly \$7,000 that was raised through fundraising from September 2008 through May 2009. Fundraising continues through August and we hope to raise over \$10,000 for the cure!
