**City of Snellville Scenario Workshop**

Snellville continues its process of the 2030 Comprehensive Plan update. The Comprehensive Plan will serve as the official long-range policy for guiding future decisions concerning land use, zoning, and public facilities for the City of Snellville. In preparing this Comprehensive Plan Update, the City is soliciting input from local residents, business owners, and other community stakeholders.

A Visioning Workshop was held on December 5, 2006 to discuss current issues, vote on land use elements, and to discuss the different character areas within the city to help identify opportunities that will affect the City's future. The information that has already been gathered is the first step in a public process that will be the framework for the development of the Comprehensive Plan Update.

A community survey to prioritize issues and opportunities that the City faces in the future is available on the project website [www.jjg.com/snellvilleplan/](http://www.jjg.com/snellvilleplan/). The information gathered on the survey is important in creating short-term and long-term planning goals. Citizens are strongly encouraged to take the survey and submit their comments.

The Scenario Workshop, to be held on **February 6, 2007**, at the Snellville City Hall – Community Room, will give citizens an opportunity to review information from the visioning workshop and to discuss the pros, cons, and possible impacts of potential future land use concepts. Three development scenarios will be presented and citizens will be asked to discuss the merits of each. The meeting will have interactive exercises and discussion groups. Citizens are encouraged to attend the February 6, Scenario Workshop. The doors will open at 6:00 p.m., and the meeting will begin at 6:30 p.m.
